Bellevue Bohol spearheads relief efforts for typhoon Odette-hit communities

The typhoon Odette landfall caused massive devastation which affected the water supply in the province and power lines, causing blackouts. A hundred Boholano indigent families can now start lighting their way to rehabilitation with solar-powered lamps donated by The Bellevue Group.



The 5-star resort also provided clean water to local communities with over a thousand families in Panglao Island to help them during the water scarcity.
